



BUILDING AND GROUNDS

To oversee maintenance of church's physical property and usage of church's physical assets.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain buildings, grounds, and equipment owned by the church.
- Keep finance ministry and budget committee informed of all major expenditures.
- Inform proper officers and Finance Ministry Team of any major structural or potential costly problems.
- Obtain prior approval for any major repairs after obtaining no less than 3 sufficient bids from vendors and considering all viable options.
- Investigate reported problems with buildings, grounds, and equipment.
- Be good stewards of all monies spent.
- Strive to get the best and most common-sense price for any replacement or repair project.
- Make use of the talents of the congregation members to provide construction and/or repairs at a fair or reduced price.
- Approve all Scout projects in advance and obtain concurrence from the session to ensure all projects are in keeping with the overall plans for and beauty of the church campus and are sent to the session for approval.
- Recommend expenditures be approved by the session from the Capital Needs Fund as stated below.
- Realize that we do not have all the answers, but we are open to counsel.

Technology Subcommittee
